



If passed by voters on May 15, 2018 the proposed \$619.7 million bond would increase the current property tax levy rate by an estimated \$1.24 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. If the bond does not pass, the additional tax would not be levied and the listed projects would not be completed. The Community Facilities Task Force reviewed all funding methods available to the district and recommended the School Board place a general obligation bond on the ballot for voters to consider. The district would receive an \$8,000,000 grant from the state if bonds are passed.

Clear Lake Elementary School

Clear Lake Elementary School is a single-story facility constructed in 1994. Two (2) portable classrooms were added to address previous enrollment growth. Fluctuating enrollment is projected through 2025. The identified building improvement projects would include HVAC upgrades, music room improvements and site drainage work. Technology and communications improvements would include expanded wireless capacity and intercom system upgrades. Bond funds would also be used to enhance safety and security by providing improved supervision of the main entry.

If the bond passes:

Improvements

- HVAC
- Music room improvements
- Site drainage improvements
- Intercom system upgrades
- Expanded wireless capacity
- Security improvements to increase visibility of main entry from office
- Removal or replacement of end-of-life portable classrooms
