



If passed by voters on May 15, 2018 the proposed \$619.7 million bond would increase the current property tax levy rate by an estimated \$1.24 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. If the bond does not pass, the additional tax would not be levied and the listed projects would not be completed. The Community Facilities Task Force reviewed all funding methods available to the district and recommended the School Board place a general obligation bond on the ballot for voters to consider. The district would receive an \$8,000,000 grant from the state if bonds are passed.

Kennedy Elementary School

Kennedy Elementary School is a single-story facility constructed in 1964. Seven (7) portable classrooms were added to address previous enrollment growth. The identified building improvement projects would include heating/ventilation upgrades, roofing replacement, music room improvements and site work. Technology and communications improvements would include expanded wireless capacity and intercom system upgrades. Bond funds would also be used to upgrade electronic badge access and improve supervision of the main entry, as well as make seismic improvements.

If the bond passes:
