



If passed by voters on May 15, 2018 the proposed \$619.7 million bond would increase the current property tax levy rate by an estimated \$1.24 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. If the bond does not pass, the additional tax would not be levied and the listed projects would not be completed. The Community Facilities Task Force reviewed all funding methods available to the district and recommended the School Board place a general obligation bond on the ballot for voters to consider. The district would receive an \$8,000,000 grant from the state if bonds are passed.

## Roberts High School

Roberts High School is a single-story facility constructed in 2005. The bond would fund the creation of a flexible STEM/CTE lab space to enhance science and career-technical curriculum options for Roberts students. This lab space would be provided by repurposing select existing classrooms. Identified building improvement projects include exterior seal and flooring replacements. Technology and communications improvements would include expanded wireless capacity and intercom system upgrades. Bond funds would also be used to upgrade electronic badge access to exterior doors.

If the bond passes:
