



# SKPS Support Facilities

If passed by voters on May 15, 2018 the proposed \$619.7 million bond would increase the current property tax levy rate by an estimated \$1.24 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. If the bond does not pass, the additional tax would not be levied and the listed projects would not be completed. The Community Facilities Task Force reviewed all funding methods available to the district and recommended the School Board place a general obligation bond on the ballot for voters to consider. The district would receive an \$8,000,000 grant from the state if bonds are passed.

If the bond passes:

## Central Services

The Central Services building is located in Northeast Salem and provides office and warehouse space supporting a variety of services such as facilities use/rentals, Custodial, Maintenance, Construction and Library-Media departments. Bond funds would be used to update the electronic badge access system.

## Lancaster Professional Center

The Lancaster Professional Center (LPC) provides office and meeting space for Safety & Risk Management, K-12 Office of Education, Community Relations & Communications, Human Resources, Financial Services, Translations, the Office of the Superintendent, Music Education, Office of Strategic Initiatives and Instructional Mentors. Bond funds would be used to fund HVAC improvements, interior renovations, make site improvements, replace windows and update the electronic badge access system.

## Nutrition Services

The Nutrition Services building is located in Southeast Salem and serves as the district's central kitchen and food distribution facility providing meal services to students. Bond funds would be used to expand the kitchen and docking area, renovate the reception area and update the electronic badge access system.

## Paulus Administrative Center

The Paulus Administrative Center provides office space for instructional support departments and programs such as the Office of Behavioral Learning and English Learner programs. Bond funds would be used to fund HVAC improvements, site work, flooring replacements, interior renovations, window replacements and update the electronic badge access system.

## Reprographics

The Reprographics Department is part of the district's Auxiliary Services, and provides design, printing and distribution services for all district schools and departments, as well as external customers. Bond funds would be used to renovate the interior, make seismic improvements and install an electronic badge access system.

## Support Services Center

The Support Services Center provides office space for Special Education, School Nursing and Counseling programs. The district's board room is also located in this facility. Bond funds would be used to provide HVAC improvements, site work, flooring replacements, interior renovations, window replacements and update the electronic badge access system.

## Technology & Information Services

The Technology & Information Services (TIS) building houses the district's student information, human resources and finance data systems and servers. It also provides office space for TIS staff members. Bond funds would be used to construct a new back-up data center at McKay High School and HVAC system improvements.

## Transportation Services

The Transportation Services building is located in Northeast Salem and provides office space and the mechanical shop for student busing and district fleet vehicle services. Bond funds would be used to fund HVAC improvements, interior renovations, site work and install an electronic badge access system.
